What is the survey?

- The Department for Education (DfE) has published a survey that lets apprentices quickly rate their Training Provider
- There are two questions to the survey that asks you to rate different aspects of the training, with an overall rating as well.



How do you access it?

 You will need to log into or create your 'My Apprenticeship' Account here: <u>Sign</u> <u>into My apprenticeship (education.gov.uk)</u>



When can you complete the survey?

- You can then complete the survey every 3 weeks until 3 months after your apprenticeship has completed.
- You can submit a survey more than once during the apprenticeship. Any responses expire after 12 months.



Why should you complete the survey?

- The survey will help your Training Provider to implement actions to improve the quality of training for you and other apprentices.
- It will allow the government to monitor the effectiveness of apprenticeship training with your provider.



Why has the DfE developed the survey?

- The government wants to empower apprentices to choose Training Providers that are of high quality.
- It helps to ensure the funding for apprenticeship is given to the right Training Providers.
- There is also an employer survey that is sent to your employer, like this one.
